

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

Social networking sites spread information faster than any other media. Hybrid vehicles save up to 30% of the fuel used in conventional vehicles. Therefore, hybrid vehicles are gaining in popularity. In addition to this, hybrid vehicles have a great impact on the atmosphere as they use less gasoline and put fewer emissions into the atmosphere which directly reduce air pollution.

Most hybrid vehicles have regenerative braking 10 systems. In conventional vehicles, the gasoline engine powers the brakes, and the energy used in braking is lost. In regenerative braking systems, the energy lost in braking is sent back into the electrical battery for use in powering the vehicle. Some hybrid vehicles have an amazing innovation. They use periodic engine shutoff as a gas-saving feature. When the vehicle is in idle, the engine temporarily turns off. When the vehicle is put back in gear, the engine comes back on. Some hybrids use tyres made of a stiff 15 material which rolls easily and prevents drag on the vehicle.

Although hybrid vehicles do represent a marked improvement in environmentally conscious engineering, there remains one significant potential drawback: battery disposal. 25 Batteries are difficult to dispose of in an environmentally safe manner. Engineers are working hard to sort out this issue. If the battery is not disposed properly, the environmental impact of a hybrid car can be greater than that of a gas car.

Since we still have two types of vehicles to choose from, we should study well their benefits as well as their drawbacks and opt for the best. As for me I think that, as hybrids become more popular, conventional vehicles should be used less in order to reduce the emissions being put into the air. I believe that hybrid vehicles are an example of an energy-efficient technology that is good for both consumers and the environment.

She was the top student of the class and in High school, she was always on the list of top ten students which really made me proud and eases my burden. Despite her disability, there is always possibility and achievement for her. She never wasted any chances or time if she sees she can do it, she will surely accomplish it.

She is 20 years old when she tried her luck to apply for a job. Luckily she passed the test and worked in a famous clothing store. With my daughter's attitude despite her disability, she only proves that there is nothing impossible in this world if we want to achieve something.
