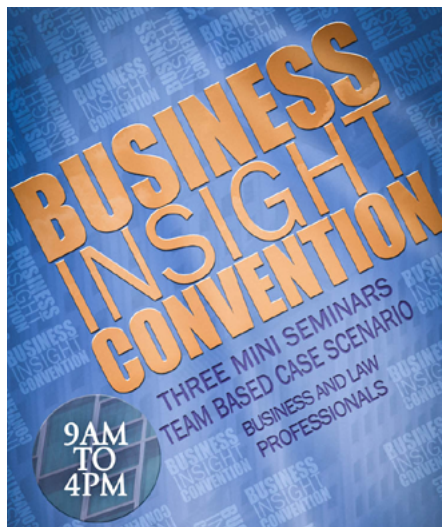
Meet Successful Business Leaders with an Education in Law.
